Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to Term 3. We look forward to a busy term as the School embarks on the second half of the academic year. The notable events that will take place in the month of July are as elaborated below.

A. UPCOMING EVENTS IN JULY 2018

1. Temperature Taking Exercise

The School will be conducting a temperature-taking exercise on **Thursday, 28 June (Term 3, Week 1)**, as required by MOE. A drill before the exercise proper will be conducted on **Wednesday, 27 June 2018**. Parents/Guardians are requested to ensure your child brings his/her thermometer for the drills and the exercise.

2. Hildan Vision Night 2018

The Hildan Vision Night 2018 will be held on **Friday, 29 June 2018, 7.00PM to 9.00PM** at the sanctuary of the Chapel of Christ the Redeemer (CCR). The theme for this event is "Many Stories, One Family". This will be an evening of recognising and thanking God for His Grace, hearing stories from students, parents and staff, as well as praying for one another. It will be an evening to treasure the Hildan Heritage, celebrate the Hildan Distinctiveness and to rededicate the Hildan family to the Hildan Vision.

3. Early dismissal due to Preliminary Oral Examination for P6 students

The Primary 6 Preliminary Oral Examination will be conducted on **Tuesday, 10 & Wednesday, 11 July 2018** respectively. Please be informed that on these 2 days, Primary 1 to Primary 5 students including Primary 4 & 5 GEP students will be dismissed at 1.15pm.

School bus operators have been informed of the changes. In the event your child is not on the school bus arrangement, please arrange for your child's transportation needs in view of the early dismissal

4. National Education (NE) Show for P5 students

Every year, the National Day Parade (NDP) Full Dress Rehearsal provides an opportunity for the organisers to inculcate National Education (NE) values in our students, instilling a sense of pride and belonging, and to convey the significance of National Day. All P5 students **will be required** to attend the P5 NE Show on **Saturday, 14 July 2018** held at the Marina Bay Floating Platform. The theme for this year's National Day is "We are Singapore!". Further details of this event involving P5 Hildans have already been sent out to parents.



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5. Youth Day (School Holiday)

Youth Day falls on Sunday, 1 July 2018. As such, students need not report to school on **Monday, 2 July 2018**. The School's General Office will be open as usual, between 8.00AM and 5.00PM.

6. Racial Harmony Day (RHD)

Racial Harmony Day is an annual national event held on 21 July to celebrate the ethnic diversity of the people in Singapore. RHD teaches students the importance of maintaining racial and religious harmony in Singapore's multicultural and multi-ethnic society. The School will be organising a series of activities to commemorate Racial Harmony **from 18 July to 20 July 2018**. The theme for this year is "Strength in Our Diversity". Through the week, traditional games and craft stalls will be set up in the School for students to participate during their recess periods. There will be a special Assembly programme on **Thursday, 12 July 2018**. Students are also encouraged to come to School in ethnic wear with school shoes on **Friday, 20 July 2018**.
