5. Public Holiday (Vesak Day)

29 May 2018 (Tuesday), is a public holiday. School will be closed on that day, and will reopen on **30 May 2018**.

6. Traffic Safety

To ensure that students arrive at school in good time, parents/guardians who drive are encouraged to have their passengers disembark at the public carparks in the vicinity of the school, and to walk the remaining distance to school. This will allow driving parents/guardians to avoid the morning peak period traffic congestion within and around the School.



Staff Well-Being & Development

Parents/Guardians who drive to drop off their children at school in the mornings are reminded to observe all traffic rules to be good role models for their children, and to be mindful of the safety of other road users. During disembarkation, parents/guardians are urged to be considerate of other road users by having their

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passengers disembark briskly in order to avoid causing traffic build-up. Importantly, vehicles should not be stopped along roads directly in front of the school's gates for disembarkation of passengers as this impedes the entry and exit of school buses into and out of the school during peak periods, creating a hazardous potential for accidents.

Parents/guardians are reminded that the school will not convey forgotten personal items delivered by families to the students. In case of need, an exception will be made for students' medication and spectacles. We seek parents'/guardians' understanding that this is part of the school's efforts to instil in our students a sense of personal responsibility for themselves and their belongings.
