## A. UPCOMING EVENTS IN SEPTEMBER 2018

### 1. **September Supplementary class (P6)**

Supplementary lessons for P6 students will be conducted on **6 & 7 September 2018** (Thursday & Friday) from 8.00am to 1.00pm. The schedule has been sent via SNAC message dated 6 August 2018. As the lessons have been planned to provide support to students in their preparation for PSLE, all students are expected to attend.

Some canteen stalls will be opened for recess during the 2 days. Please make the necessary after-school transport arrangements for your child.

### 2. **PSLE Listening Comprehension (P6)**

The school will be closed to **Primary 1 to Primary 5 students** on **14 September 2018**, for the 2018 PSLE Listening Comprehension. Primary 1 to Primary 5 students will carry out home-based e-learning, and complete assignments via the various e-learning platforms detailed in the table below.

### 3. **School Holidays**

The school holidays period will be from **1 to 9 September 2018**. Students are to return to school on Monday, 10 September 2018. During the school holidays period, the School Administration Office will open on weekdays from 8.00am to 5.00pm.



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## 4. PSLE Written Examination 2018

The PSLE Written Examination 2018 will be held from **27 September to 3 October**. Primary 6 students are required to report to school by 7.30 a.m., and will take the examination in the school hall. Students taking the examinations will be **dismissed early** on each of the examination days. Students taking Non-Tamil Indian Language (NTIL) and students who are exempted from Mother Tongue Language, **do not** need to report to school on **Monday, 1 October 2018** (Mother Tongue Language papers).

Further details on the PSLE Written Examination 2018 will be given in a separate letter.

Lessons for Primary 1 to Primary 5 students during the 5 days of the PSLE Written Examination will be as per normal.
