A. Upcoming Events in April 2019

1. International Friendship Day (IFD)

International Friendship Day (IFD) commemoration will be held on 10 and 11 April 2019. Special activities will be carried out during recess for students over these 2 days. There will be a performance for our students during their weekly assembly session on Thursday, 11 April, to commemorate IFD. School curriculum hours remain unchanged.

2. Founder's Day

Founder's Day will be celebrated on 12 April 2019. School will be closed on that day. However, selected students will be invited to participate in the event which will be jointly observed with the St Hilda's Secondary School in view of this being our 85th Anniversary year. More details will be made available closer to the date.

The annual prize-presentation segment will be carried out on 5 July in Term 3. Parents of students concerned will receive a letter separately about this event.

3. Semestral Assessment 1 (SA1) Oral Examination - P3 to P6

The SA1 Oral Examination for P3 to P6 students will be held on the dates in the following table. Please be reminded that the examinations will end by 4.00PM. Students will be given their lunch break from 1.15PM TO 1.45PM before the examination starts. There will be school bus service provided after the examination.

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4. Earth Week @SHPS

The school will be celebrating Earth Week from 22 to 26 April 2019. This year, the theme for Earth Day is 'Protect Our Species'. There will be an Assembly talk on "Reduce and Reuse", a pre-assembly presentation by Science E2k students, recess activities at the canteen anchored by our Student Councillors and Science E2k students, and Playscape activities supported by our Parent Support Group.

5. National Physical Fitness Award/Assessment (NAPFA) Tests for P4 & P6 students (GEP included)

The NAPFA is a test of physical fitness for students in Singapore. It is compulsory for all students in P4 and P6 levels. Further details of this event which will be conducted in April will be sent out separately closer to the date.
