## **A. UPCOMING EVENTS IN MAY 2019**

### **1. P1 to P6 Parent-Child-Teachers Conference (PCTC) Session**

The PCTC for P1 to P6 is scheduled on **31 May 2019 (Friday)**. Details have been separately conveyed via SNAC™ to parents. All students are to be in school uniform when attending the PCTC.

### **2. Primary 6 Supplementary Classes (June Holiday)**

Please take note that the Primary 6 Supplementary classes will be held over 3 days from **24 June to 26 June 2019**, from 8.00AM to 1.00PM. More details will be given closer to the date via SNAC™.

## **B. GENERAL ADMINISTRATION**

### **3. June School Holidays**

Term 2 will end on 31 May 2019, with the school holidays commencing from Saturday, 1 June 2019. Students are to return to School on **1 July 2019 (Monday)**.

### **4. Student Travel Declaration**

Student travel declaration for the upcoming mid-year school holidays (1 June to 30 June 2019) is necessary to facilitate contact tracing in the event of an epidemic or emergency situation. Parents/Guardians are required to make a declaration if their children/wards are travelling during the specified period. Parents/Guardians of **ALL P1 children** **are required** to declare the travel plans of their P1 children, **regardless of whether the child is going overseas.**

### **5. Public Holidays**

**1 May 2019 (Labour Day)** and **20 May 2019 (Vesak Day)** being public holidays, the school will be closed on both dates.

### **6. Traffic Safety**

Parents/Guardians who drive to drop off their children at school in the mornings are reminded to observe all traffic rules to be good role models for their children, and to be mindful of the safety of other road users.



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During disembarkation of passengers, parents/guardians are urged to be considerate of other road users by having their passengers disembark briskly in order to avoid causing traffic build-up behind their vehicle. Vehicles should not be stopped directly in front of the school's gates for disembarkation of passengers as this impedes the entry and exit of school buses and other vehicles into and out of the school during peak periods, creating a hazardous potential for accidents.

To avoid congesting the roads immediately around the school, driving parents/guardians are strongly advised to park their vehicles at neighbouring public carparks and to walk their children to school instead.

## **7. Updating of students' personal details**

Parents/guardians are reminded to promptly update the school of any changes in the administrative details related to their children, particularly parents'/guardians' contact details. It is essential that the School's student database is accurate to facilitate expeditious action in any contingency.

## **8. Measures to ensure student well-being in the hot weather**

Students have been informed that they can wear the PE attire everyday with immediate effect, in view of the hot weather we are currently experiencing. The duration of this provision will be received at a later date.
